

Intern Application and Selection Process

The CTE Intern Program allows more advanced CTE students to receive more rigorous theatrical training while functioning as salaried employees of the CTE staff. Interns are given training in child development, teaching methods and all aspects of theatre and are then given the opportunity to utilize this training by working during the CTE workshops as teachers, directors and technicians. Other responsibilities may include creating, directing and/or choreographing original pieces for Arts Festival productions, attending briefing meetings, leading daily circle groups and classes and role-modeling the CTE philosophy. Students applying for the intern program should plan on participating for more than one year, as learning is a building process.

Requirements for Intern Application

- At least 2 years as a CTE student
- Must be at least 14 years old (or be at least 14 before CTE starts)
- Must have completed 9th grade once CTE starts, but have no more than one year of college
- Leadership experience with children (may be drawn from past CTE experience)
- Must be available for the entire length of the CTE season
- Must have demonstrated ability to work unsupervised

Application Procedure

- Interested students should download an application from CTE website (www.ctekids.org)
- Application must be completed and returned to the Artistic Director by the student no later than April 1, 2019 (email to ctecontact@gmail.com)
- Select students will interview with members of the Staffing Committee in April 2019
- Prior to interviewing, applicants should review and become familiar with the **CTE Policy Manual for Faculty, Staff & Interns and Code of Conduct** (download from www.ctekids.org)
