CTE Scholarship Policy

It is the intent of CTE to provide tuition scholarships to children in need whenever fiscally possible. If you wish to apply for a scholarship for your child[ren], please print and complete the form found on the website. Send it to us with proof of your qualification for free or reduced school lunch and **any other documents confirming your present level of income (this is required)**. You may want to include further information you wish the Board to be aware of while reviewing your request.

1. Scholarship applications must be **RECEIVED** at time of registration. The Board will review each scholarship application and will notify you by email if a scholarship has been awarded.
2. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of need and on a first-come first-served basis. Priority is given to those qualifying for free or reduced lunch and who submit proof thereof.
3. Scholarship awards are limited to a maximum of **50% of total tuition**.
4. Recipient's portion of tuition must be paid by **April 30**.

CTE is a non-profit organization with minimal paid staff and relies on the support of volunteers to provide quality summer programming for children. If your family receives a scholarship, one way to provide support for CTE is to volunteer with the organization during the summer.
